
God accompanies us in every step of our Spiritual growth. We are especially strengthened by Jesus Christ as He nourishes us in the Eucharist, week after week.

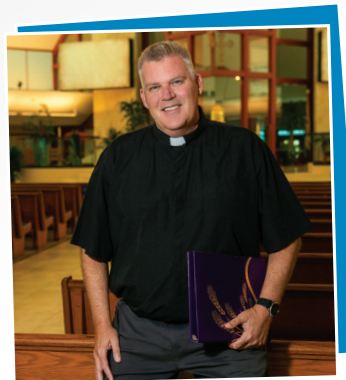
